It's my privilege to serve as the Chemeketa Foundation's Board President and share our 2016 Annual Report with you. In 2016, **1,614** students applied for Chemeketa Foundation scholarships; **504 scholarships** were awarded; **\$5,252** was the estimated cost of attending Chemeketa for one term (tuition, fees, books, rent, transportation, personal expenses, etc.) and **\$1,200** was our average annual scholarship award.

I hope you'll continue to keep the Chemeketa Foundation at the top of your list of philanthropic priorities. Because of you and your support, we are making college possible and changing lives one student at a time. Thank you.

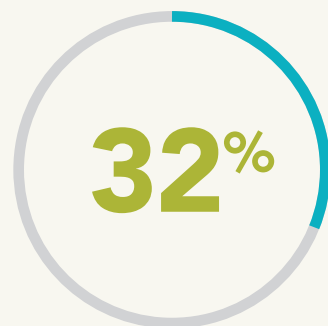

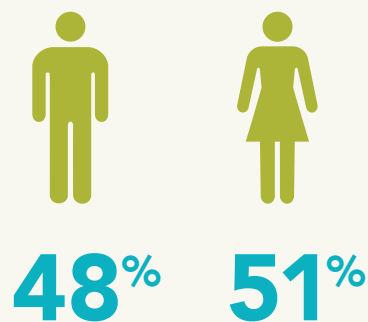

They established the George Puentes Jr. Memorial Scholarship in memory of George Puentes Jr. whose life exemplified his commitment to educational excellence. Since that time, SOL has awarded more than 150 scholarships.

#### GEORGE PUENTES JR. MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

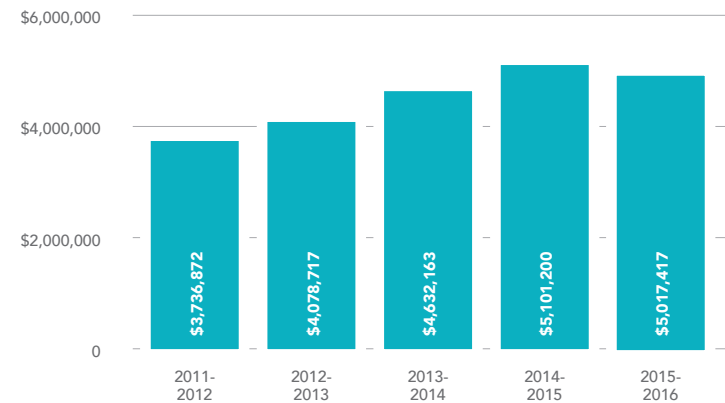

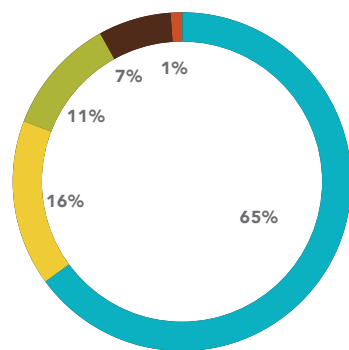
# dollars & cents

## SCHOLARSHIP INVESTMENT FUND

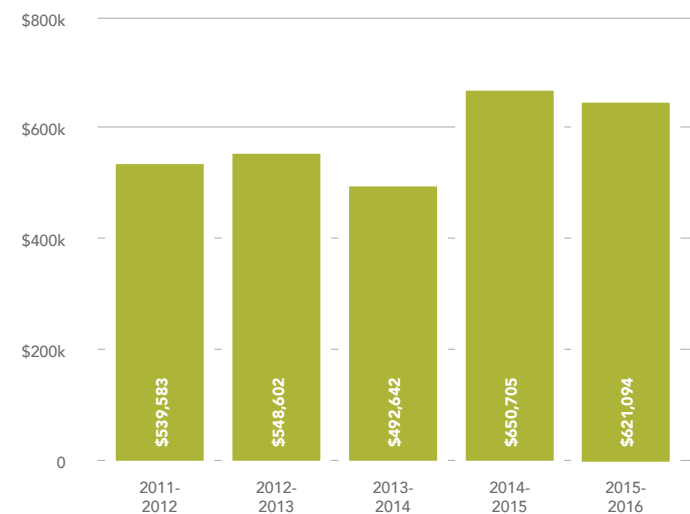
The Foundation Board of Directors oversees scholarship and program investment funds.

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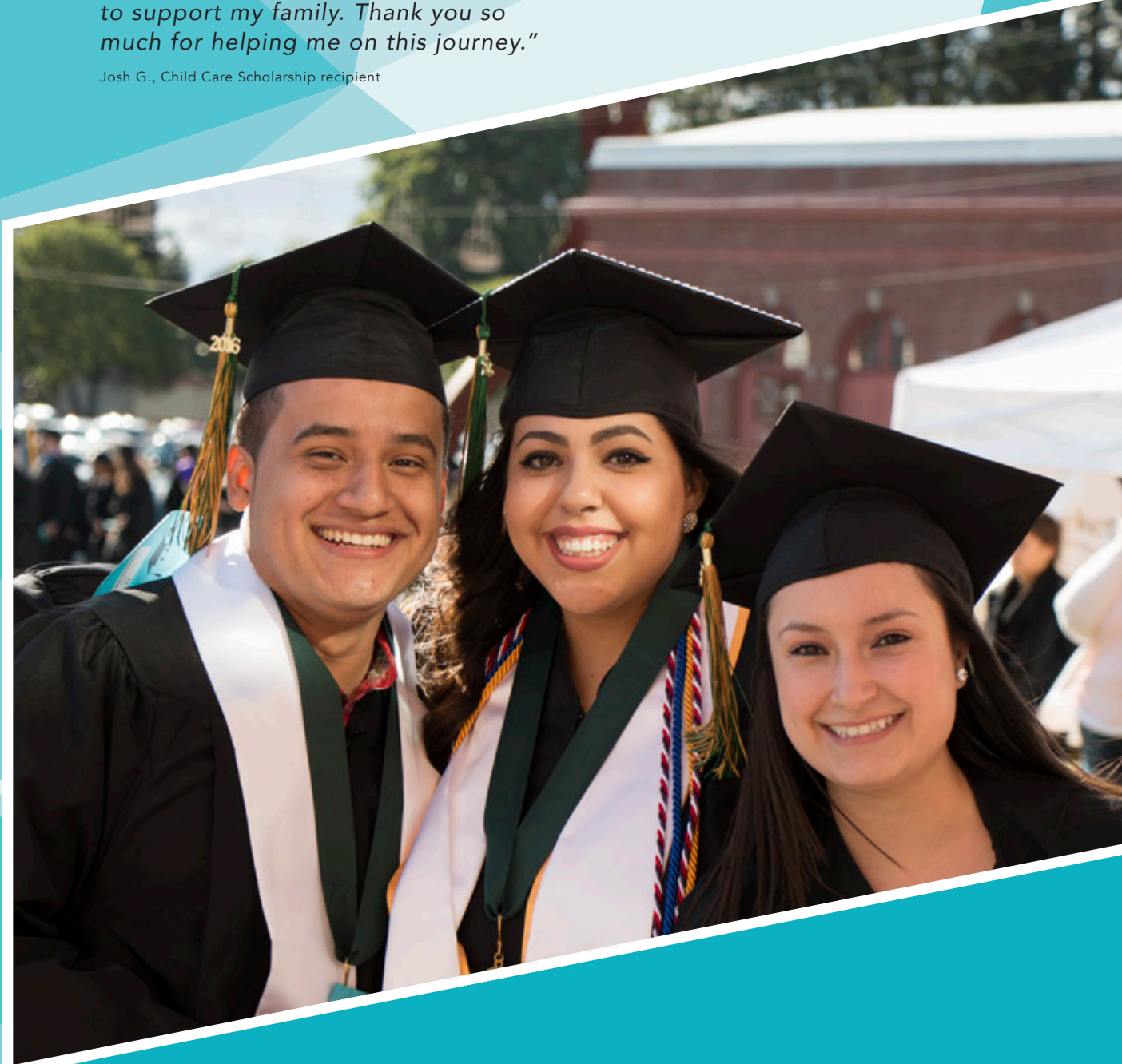
